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Invented in 1985 – suppressed in Germany till today: the AIDS Hometest

There is an AIDS quick test that can be bought and used privately and without any supervision.

No embarrassing situations, no blemishing from the side of authorities. No humiliation, no snooping. Once bought, it's available when needed (sexual contacts are the most pleasant when they are spontaneous, not only during the carnival period). **Much safer than condoms.** The test result is available in a few minutes. Foolproof handling (not suited for blind people). You better buy it in time to have it at hand when needed. (As early as in 2001, we distributed a mass leaflet on the subject.)

We cannot exclude difficulties in ordering or delivery of the home test because of its suppression by the state!

These tests can, however, only be bought via Internet, because they are prohibited in Germany. No physician is allowed to prescribe them, no pharmacist may sell them! Only trained medical staff or information centers at which the state forces people to seek counselling, as, for instance, the state authorized AIDS-Aid Center, shall be allowed to use them. The sale or distribution to individuals is prohibited since March 2010.

In order to put a stop to the sheepish re-bleating of the propaganda of the lack of safety of the home test which usually sets in at this point, we would like to briefly explain once more: due to the late sero-conversion, i.e. the development of antibodies, with quick tests like with any available ELISA screening tests that are applied otherwise (all of which are designed to detect HIV antibodies) it can actually take up to 3 months until antibodies are detected. But apart from the fact that the same HIV quick tests have been officially used and relied on for years for the purpose of conducting mass tests of the people (as, for instance, in Ghana), the risk of an infection is considerably reduced by a quick test conducted immediately before a sexual contact (5 minutes). Without a test, however, any sexual contact becomes a kind of »Russian Roulette« and untroubled spontaneous sexuality is thus not possible.

As early as in 1985 (!), Elliott Millenson developed a home test in the USA, which he submitted to the FDA for approval in 1986. This test could have been produced at such low cost that "government could even give away home tests to those who could not afford one"*. The FDA, however, briskly refused: "FDA told me they would 'probably never' consider a rapid AIDS test". And the situation has not changed until this very day. In the year 1985, there were no more than 500 HIV infected people in Germany according to official records; just allow yourself the thought and imagine the home test would have been available immediately and our tax money which – without asking us – was thrown away for the cynical propaganda for the use of condoms, had instead been invested in vending machines for home tests from the very beginning – would we still be faced with this epidemic today? Or is there anyone who still remembers SARS? Millions of victims could have been avoided – and the rest would no longer suffer from the deadly fear of getting infected. What a crime!

Never before in the history of mankind has an epidemic been fostered, preserved and prevented from extinction the way AIDS was. Meanwhile horrendous figures are to be read, the sources of which, however, are to be looked at with caution due to the lack of mass tests on a worldwide scale, and – on top of that – the responsible authorities are pretending the epidemic, like a stroke of fate, had taken an unavoidable course. This exactly is a lie! **By means of classical hygienic measures for the control of epidemics as well as mass testing, the millions and millions of victims COULD HAVE BEEN AVOIDED.** Instead, lies – i.e. misinformation against better knowledge – were purposefully fabricated and spread from the very beginning. Just remember: once AIDS had become known, the Ministry of Health with its head Süßmuth as the leading figure pursued the strategy of playing down the risk of infection. In unison, all newspapers spread the legend about the HI virus' selective choice of host: only homosexuals, junkies and prostitutes would be affected by AIDS, just as if some pseudo-creature («virus« means poison in Latin) was able to differentiate between sexual preferences or other habits of its victims and, moreover, to selectively find out and affect those that are considered condemnable according to the ruling moral standards. Contrary to the facts that were well-known and accessible at that time, »normal« individuals were persuaded into a safety that does not exist, and the only reasonable conclusion, i.e. to apply the laws for the control of epidemics as usual plus screening, was thus torpedoed. The duty of notification was demonized from the very first day, pretending that it constituted a discrimination against infected persons – a hue and cry that was never to be heard in earlier times, in the case of syphilis, for instance; by now, the duty of notification for venereal diseases has been abolished altogether. Those who demanded the uncompromising application of measures for the control of epidemics, as we did in 1985 already, were labelled as fascists – a twofold absurdity in this case and the first time, by the way, that the consistently nonsensical usage of this word, triggering the reflex to kill in the minds of the idiots among the subjects, was introduced. (Actually, Hitler had not been an enemy of venereal diseases, and large-scale operations by the state for the benefit of public health have never been typical of fascist states; on the contrary: it was a characteristic of the »welfare states« to fight such diseases, and, in proportion to their material resources, of the socialist states that fought them even more resolutely. Knowledge is rewarding, indeed. Knowledge of history, of facts, of useful addresses. And readers of the KETZERBRIEFE [Heretics' Letters] are becoming more intelligent altogether.
